Jazaak ALLAHU Khairan for explaining this *Hadiith* to us, with its grammatical significance and *tafsiir*.

Which verb does رُوَيْدًا deputize?

Answer from our Shaykh (quote)

Dear Shahneen,

wa alaykumussalaam

I am glad you liked the explanation of the *Hadiith*.

The verb is:

أَفْعَلَ *baab* أَرُوْدَ يُرُوْدُ إِرُوَادًا

Note that in this verb the *waaw* does not undergo إِغْلَالٌ ,
i.e., the verb does not become:

أَرَادَ يُرِيدُ.

The word رُوَيْدٌ is the *taSghir* of إِرُوَادَ, but this is irregular.

The verb is not much used.

Only رُوَيْدًا is used to deputize the verb.

I hope this has helped you to understand.
