السلام عليكم

The gender of the 'adad is determined by the gender of the  $ma' d\bar{u} d$ .

Here we have to take into consideration the singular  $ma' d\bar{u}d$ , (بَيْت) not the plural because, as you know, all plurals are feminine.

So we say:

ثَلاَثَةُ كُتُبٍ وَأَرْبَعُ مَجَلاّت

because مَجَلَّة is masculine, and مَجَلَّة is feminine.
