

I am confused about its being a na't of an omitted $maf'\bar{u}l muțlaq$ or a $maf'\bar{u}l$ of an omitted verb?

Fadīlat al-Shaykh Dr. V. Abdur Rahim (حفظه الله) replies:



وعليكم السلام

Your first conjecture is correct. The taqdir is:

فَلْيَغْسِلْ غَسَلاتٍ سَبْعاً

Here غَسْلاًت is the plural of غَسْلاًت which is masdar marrah.

It is like:

سَجَدْتُ سَجَدَاتٍ ثَلاَثًاً

The word سَبْعاً is *na^ct*.

Hope this is clear.
