They are close in meaning (or synonyms), and it's difficult to understand the difference.

I hope you can also recommend which books and dictionaries are good for understanding words close in meaning.

حفظكَ الله Dear Br Said
وعليكم السلام

Yes, سَرَّح and are synonyms to some extent, but there are some differences between them.

I think one must learn these words when they find them in reliable books. They can find out the difference in their meanings from dictionaries like الصِّحَاحُ and الْمصصْاحُ الْمُمُنير.

There is a very good dictionary in English. Its name is مَدّ الْقَامُوس by Edward Lane. You may consult this.

With regard to Qur'ānic words you may consult:


There is a subtle difference between الالْتُقَيَاد and الاسْتُسْاَامَا The first is a mental activity while the second is a physical activity. Mentally and spiritually one submits, but being 'led' to acts of piety is more physical.
