Question

Why is نصف *mansūb* in the following sentence?:

«كِتَابْتُكُمْ نَصْفَ صَفْحَةٍ بِخَطٍّ جَمِيلٍ أَحَبُّ إِلَيَّ مِنْ ...»

(From: Madinah Book 3).

Is it a *maf'ūl bihī* of the *maṣdar* كِتابَتُ؟

If yes, then is its *taqdīr* :

«أَنْ تَكْتُبُوا نَصْفَ صَفْحَةٍ بِخَطٍّ جَمِيلٍ أَحَبُّ إِلَيَّ ...؟»

You are right. It is the *maf'ūl bihī* of the *māṣdar*.

Your reconstruction of the *taqdīr* is also correct.

This reconstructed *māṣdar mu'awwal* «أنْ تَكْتُبُوا» is the *mubtada'*, and its *khabar* is «أَحَبُّ».«
