The pattern «يَفْعُولْ» has quite a few words.

In addition to يَحْمُومٌ, another word of this pattern occurs in the Glorious Qur'ān. It is يَنْبُوعٌ water spring which occurs in 17:90.

Here are some important words of this pattern:

- 🥠 يُعْسُو بُّ, a drone (a male bee).
- o يَو بُوعٌ , a field rat.
- o پَحْمُورٌ, a wild ass. In modern Arabic this word is used for 'haemoglobin'.
- و پَأْفُو خٌ و , part of the head in a newborn baby where it is very soft.
- a male deer. يَعْفُورُ
- o یَخْضُورٌ, in modern Arabic it is used for chlorophyll.

In your letter you wrote 'wazan'. This is not right. The correct word is 'wazn' وُزْنٌ.
