Dear Br Muhammad

means dust.

means, 'His nose was covered with dust'.

This is a metaphor for 'he was humiliated, disgraced' denoting that he was knocked down in such a way that his nose (and face) were covered with dust. From this comes the idea of humiliation.

'I did this in spite of him.'

The verb رغم is used in two $b\bar{a}bs$: i-a and a-u.
