«مَاءُ زَمْزَمَ»



Question

In this sentence:

«مَاءُ زَمْزَمَ مَاءٌ مُبَارَكٌ»

the first مَاءُ is *mubtada'*, but what is the second مَاءٌ ?

And مُبَارَكٌ is a *na'at* of which word?

Dear Br abuaicha

وعليكم السلام

Here is the answer to your question:

«مَاءٌ زَمْرَمٌ مَاءٌ مُبَارَكٌ».

- «مَاءٌ» is *mubtada'*, and it is also *muḍāf*,
- and «زَمْرَمٌ» is its *muḍāf ilayhi majrūr*.

As it is a diptote, it has *fathah* as its *'alāmat al-jarri*.

- «مَاءٌ» is its *khobar*,
- and «مُبَارَكٌ» is *naʿt* of «مَاءٌ».

Hope this is clear.
