Most مَنْصُوبُ nouns take an additional أَلِفٌ like

رَشِيداً,

حَمِيداً,

بِلَالاً.

Is there any reason for this?

The مَنْصُوب noun is written with an أَلِف because in the pause mode it is pronounced with an أَلْف, e.g.,

جَزَاكَ اللهُ خَيْرًا

jazākallāhu khayraa.

This does not apply to a noun ending in تَاءٌ مَرْبُوطَةٌ because in pause mode the تَاءٌ مَرْبُوطَةٌ is changed to *h*.
